### Car parking:

At the front of the school Jazz2Go (adult) members should enter through the **right-hand gate** and use the front car park. Youth members should enter through the **left-hand gate**, then follow the road up towards the Sports Centre and use the left side car park or outside the Sports Hall (ahead and on the right side). Parking on the roadside is not allowed (yellow lines).

### Where do our groups rehearse?

#### GYJA

Please enter the Sports Hall via the signed entrance, go through the double doors, turn right and follow the right-hand corridor past the Gym and the Art department. Follow this corridor round to the left and as you enter the Music department we rehearse in the second classroom on the right-hand side.

\* Please aim to arrive on-site for 5.45pm at latest to allow time to park/drop-off, get to room, set-up, tune-up and warm-up.

#### GYJO

Please enter the Sports Hall via the signed entrance, go through the double doors, turn right and follow the right-hand corridor past the Gym and the Art department. Follow this corridor round to the left and after entering the Music department turn left again. We rehearse in the very last classroom at the very end of the corridor.

\* Please aim to arrive on-site for 6.45pm at latest to allow time to park/drop-off, get to room, set-up, tune-up and warm-up.

#### Jazz2Go

Please enter the Sixth form centre via the signed entrance, go through the main door, follow the corridor ahead, turn right and enter the first room on your left.

\* Please aim to arrive on-site for 6.45pm at latest to allow time to park/drop-off, get to room, set-up, tune-up and warm-up.

### FAQ – What do we need to bring?

Please bring:

- Your instrument
- Any instrument accessories you need (mouthpieces, reeds, slings, mutes, leads, sticks etc.)
- A music stand
- 2 pencils is advised
- Any rhythm section members (piano / keyboard, guitar, bass, drum, kit) or singers – the band director will inform you what you need to bring in terms of equipment.
