Whole Class Ensemble Tuition (WCET)

Our schemes of work are designed for KS1, KS2 & KS3 pupils from **Reception to Year 7**. Our prices include instrument hire and resources.

We recommend the following whole class instruments for the following year groups:

Violin – Reception to Year 7

Mixed strings (mix of violin, viola & cello) – Reception to Year 7

Infant Strings – Reception to Year 2

Guitar – Year 3 to Year 7

What is Whole Class Ensemble Teaching?

WCET is a core role within the National Plan for Music Education and is 50% funded by Arts Council England (ACE). The plan requires all pupils to receive a minimum of 10 weeks formal tuition through this scheme throughout their schooling life.

WCET must be free at point of delivery for you pupils.

Our lessons are delivered by experienced staff working alongside your class teacher/TA with the whole class learning the same instrument. Lessons are based on 45m contact time with 15m setup/pack away time.

Small group and individual tuition is available for those pupils who wish to continue their studies after WCET has finished. Please see overleaf for details.

Small group tuition

This scheme is designed to allow parents an affordable and accessible way for their child to receive high quality tuition from a team of experienced tutors and to maximise continuation from WCET.

Children can access lessons in groups (3 – 5 pupils), paired lessons or individual lessons and charged directly by Gloucestershire Music – no financial risk to your school.

Paired Tuition 30m **£91.50**

Individual Tuition 20m **£121.50**

Prices are based on 10 sessions per term.
